

# Participant Gate Guard Job Description

The Participant Gate near First Aide will remain open all day, hence the staff member assigned to it. A two-way radio will be available to each Greeter who is stationed at the Participant Gate in case of question(s) or emergency.

At the scheduled start time, please report to the Upper Front Gate where you will receive instruction from the ADO or DOO.

## **Duties Include:**

- Checking passes through rear entrance gate of the fairgrounds, only allowing those with proper credentials (Participant Pass) on the grounds prior to the opening of the Front Gate, and all passes must be checked in the course of the day to ensure proper personnel are using that particular entry/exit.
- Providing general shire information to participants in that area.
- Promoting and maintaining a positive, professional image for The Pennsylvania Renaissance Faire.

## **Qualifications:**

- Participant Gate Guards MUST possess an ability to be assertive in their duties.
- Must have steady transportation.
- Must be friendly and able to work well with others.

## **Working Conditions:**

- Must be able to work a combination of indoors and outdoors in all weather conditions.
- Must be able to sit for long periods at a time.
- Requires standing, bending, lifting, and walking.
- Must be able to work weekends and holidays.
